Graduation Assessment Schedule British Columbia, Yukon and Offshore Schools

IMPORTANT NOTES

1. There is no August Provincial Assessment/Exam session in 2020.
2. The written component of the Évaluation de littératie de la 10^e année – Français langue première (LTP10) must be completed in the morning of the scheduled assessment day since it has an oral component that students must complete **AFTER** finishing the written component. Headphones are required for **BOTH** the written and the oral components. Microphones are required for the oral component. For important instructions regarding the oral component, please refer to the *Guide de gestion de la composante orale*.
3. June 2020 is the final offering of the grade 12 language arts suite of exams.
4. Exams highlighted in **yellow** are only available to students who:
 - a. are writing an exam for the first time having **completed the school portion** of the corresponding course by midnight on June 30th, 2019 **OR**
 - b. are writing an exam for the first time, are **enrolled in an DL school and started** the corresponding course by midnight on June 30th, 2019 **OR**
 - c. are rewriting an exam previously attempted
5. Start and end times should be adhered to by all schools. However, if necessary, schools may begin up to one hour before the scheduled start time to accommodate local schedule conflicts (e.g., bus schedules). Students must remain in the supervised room for a minimum of one hour after the original scheduled start time (e.g., begin at 12 noon but ensure students do not leave until after 2:00 p.m.).
6. All Graduation Assessments and Provincial Exams are designed to be completed within two hours. Students are permitted up to 60 additional minutes, if required.
7. All sessions are electronic only:
NOTE: The Numeracy Assessment also has a two-page, paper student response component.
8. The Ministry of Education aims to ensure this schedule does not change. Occasionally circumstances require changes after it is initially published. Should changes be required, the Ministry of Education will communicate these changes via email through the Deputy Minister's Bulletin and via a TRAX Update.
